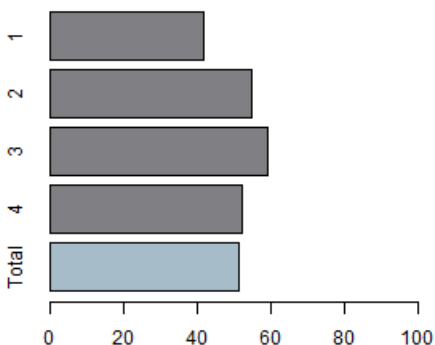
The bar chart below shows Saudi Arabia's total risk scores in 4 domains: (1) Business Interactions with Government, (2) Anti-Bribery Laws and Enforcement (3) Government and Civil Service Transparency and (4) Capacity for Civil Society Oversight. The four domain scores are weighted and combined and a risk penalty is added for individual domain scores that exceed the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain, and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery.

**1. Business Interactions with Government:** Saudi Arabia scores 42 on this measure, indicating moderate risk of intensive interaction with the government, moderate regulatory burden, and a moderate expectation of bribes.

**2. Anti-Bribery Laws and Enforcement:** Saudi Arabia's score of 55 is moderate.

**3. Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Saudi Arabia's score of 59 indicates a moderate quality of administration and governmental transparency.

**4. Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Saudi Arabia's score of 52 suggests a moderate risk.
