



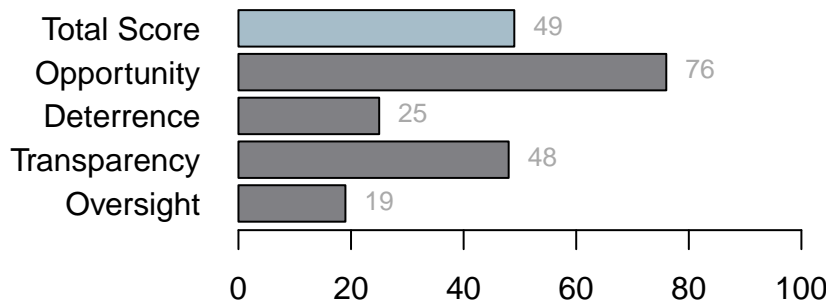
Marshall Islands

Overall Risk Score: 49

Risk Level: medium

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

1. **Business Interactions with Government:** The Marshall Islands receives a poor score of 76 in this domain, based on a high degree of government interaction.
2. **Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** The Marshall Islands receives a good score of 25 in this domain, based on a high quality of anti-bribery dissuasion and a high quality of anti-bribery enforcement.
3. **Government and Civil Service Transparency:** The Marshall Islands receives a medium score of 48 in this domain, based on medium governmental transparency.
4. **Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** The Marshall Islands receives a good score of 19 in this domain, based on a very high degree of media freedom/quality and a high degree of civil society engagement.
