



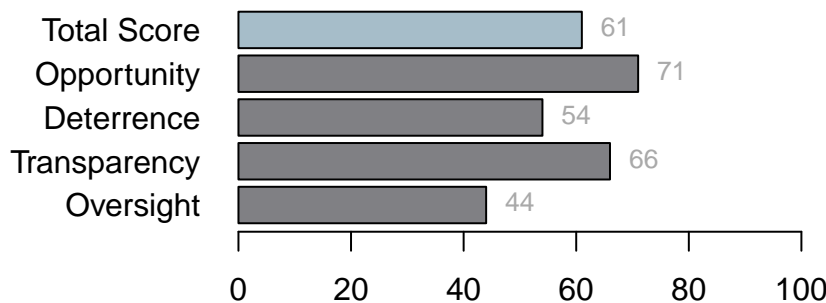
Papua New Guinea

Overall Risk Score: 61

Risk Level: high

This score is a composite of the four domain scores discussed below, which are weighted and combined to produce the overall country risk score. Each country is given a score from 1 to 100 for each domain and for the total bribery risk. A higher score indicates a higher risk of business bribery. Assessments of whether a given domain score is “good” or “poor” are made relative to all other jurisdictions within that domain.

- Business Interactions with Government:** Papua New Guinea receives a poor score of 71 in this domain, based on a medium degree of government interaction, a high expectation of bribes, and a very high regulatory burden.
- Anti-bribery Deterrence and Enforcement:** Papua New Guinea receives a medium score of 54 in this domain, based on a medium quality of anti-bribery dissuasion and a medium quality of anti-bribery enforcement.
- Government and Civil Service Transparency:** Papua New Guinea receives a poor score of 66 in this domain, based on poor governmental transparency and poor transparency of financial interests.
- Capacity for Civil Society Oversight:** Papua New Guinea receives a medium score of 44 in this domain, based on a medium degree of media freedom/quality and a medium degree of civil society engagement.
